## Irregularities

---

Details of written allegations of irregularities, and action taken by AEC:

On 28 May 2021 the AEC received correspondence advising that an application had been made to the Federal Court for an inquiry into this election on the basis of the following alleged irregularities:

- I. Financial members of the Manufacturing Division who were entitled to vote were not included on the roll of voters; and
- II. Certain financial members of the Manufacturing Division who were entitled to nominate had their nominations rejected by the Returning Officer

With regard to the allegation that members were not included on the roll, the AEC sought and received a declaration from the Division Secretary certifying that the list contained the name of every member who was financial at the close of roll. The Divisional Secretary also declared that the register of members has been maintained as required by s. 230(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*. Subsequent updates to the roll made declarations in similar terms.

With regard to the allegation that members who were entitled to nominate had their nominations rejected, the Returning Officer contacted all nominees prior rejecting their nominations and provided an opportunity for them to rectify the apparent defect. The Returning Officer then made a decision based the information provided.


Details:


