Rules specifying the method of lodgement of nominations were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for potential candidates to nominate. Instead nominations were received electronically, via email/the AEC's portal.

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 24 January and 26 February 2020 the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission (Commission) prescribed information for an election to fill a range of offices for the remainder of the term due to insufficient nominations received in a previous election (**E2019/42**). The prescribed information included the following offices among those for which elections were sought:

South Australian Branch

Rank and File Female State Councillor (1)

Rank and File Delegate to State Administrative Committee (2)

Tasmanian Branch

Rank and File Female State Councillor (1)

[2] On 24 January and 26 February 2020 the AMWU also lodged with the Commission prescribed information for an election to fill casual vacancies for offices for the remainder of their term. Those offices included the following office:

New South Wales Branch

Rank and File National Councillor (1)

[3] On 6 March 2020, a Delegate of the Commissioner (the Delegate), issued a decision in this matter indicating that he was satisfied that an election for offices, including the abovenamed offices, was required to be held under the rules of the AMWU, and under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (RO Act) made arrangements for the election to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC).

[4] On 24 March 2020, the AEC advised the AMWU that it had temporarily suspended industrial elections due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The suspension subsequently remained in

place until 8 October 2020, at which time the AEC advised that it was progressively recommencing the timetabling of industrial elections. The AMWU has informed the Commission that it has made enquiries with the AEC about the timetabling of this election, and as a result the AMWU has advised the Commission that this election has not yet been conducted.

[5] Subsequent to the lodgements of prescribed information for casual vacancies and insufficient nominations outlined above, on 22 September and 27 October 2020, the AMWU lodged with the Commission prescribed information for a scheduled election for offices which has included the abovenamed offices. On 30 October 2020, the Delegate issued a decision (**E2020/184**) arranging for the AEC to conduct that election.

[6] In its recent communications with the AEC about the timetabling of the election to fill casual vacancies and insufficient nominations (**E2020/17**), the AMWU alerted the AEC to the fact that the four offices referred to above have also been listed for election in the upcoming scheduled elections for a new term of office (E2020/184). The AMWU stated that it wishes to prevent a situation where an election for offices would occur under E2020/17, in circumstances where the very same offices will be the subject of a scheduled election to occur immediately thereafter, in or around July 2021, under (E2020/184).

[7] In light of this, and in order to avoid an unnecessary duplication of elections for the abovenamed offices, the decision issued by the Delegate on 6 March 2020 in this matter (**E2020/17**) is therefore amended as follows:

By removing from the list of offices under paragraph [1] the following words as they apply to the **South Australian Branch**:
