Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 9 August 2021 the Queensland Police Branch (the Branch) of the Police Federation of Australia (the organisation) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices:

- [2] I note that the above offices of the Branch were the subject of a separate election decision namely [2020] ROCD 151 (PR351741) issued on 24 September 2020 in matter E2020/166, but that election has been delayed and is yet to be completed by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) with delays arising from the COVID-19 pandemic and associated restrictions. However, according to correspondence received from the organisation, nominations for E2020/166 are due to open 3 September 2021.
- [3] Given the one-year term of the offices involved, it would be both practical and favourable that the currently timetabled election (E2020/166) also serve as the election sought in the prescribed information for matter E2021/158. The circumstances are such that these offices are elected for a one-year term and the passage of time has seen the prescribed information for 2021 'catch up' to the 2020 prescribed information.
- [4] The conduct of a single election will serve to negate the possibility of back-to-back elections arising and will provide a means by which the election schedule set out in the organisation's rules can realign to its normal timetable.
- [5] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

## Dates and time of nominations opening and closing

The Manager must fix the opening day and closing day for nominations for an office – see Part CF2, sub-rule 45(a).

The closing day must be at least 28 days after notice is given under rule 47 – see Part CF2, sub-rule 45(b).

Nominations open at midday on the opening day and close at midday on the closing day – see Part CF2, sub-rule 45(c).

Day provided for in the rules as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed

30 days before the starting time for nominations – see Part CF2, sub-rule 43(a)(iii) and rule 52.
