- I, Susan Hopgood, being the Federal Secretary of the Australian Education Union make the following statement:
 - 1. I am the Federal Secretary of the Australian Education Union and am authorised to sign this prescribed information in relation to elections which are required to be held for the undermentioned offices in this Union (Annexure A Federal Executive Delegates)
 - 2. I confirm that the following information is being lodged under subsection 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009.
