Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 20 October 2021 the Communications Division (**the Division**) of the Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices, due to insufficient nominations received in a previous election (**E2018/281**):

South Australia & Northern Territory Communications Division Branch

Branch Committee of Management Member (honorary) from the following sections:

Postal Services Industry Section (1)

Telecommunications and Information Technology Industry Section (2)

- [2] I note that the Division's letter dated 20 October 2021, which accompanied the prescribed information lodged in this matter, acknowledges that it relates to offices for which insufficient nominations were received in an election declared on 17 April 2019, i.e. more than two years ago.
- [3] The letter also notes that the lodgement of prescribed information follows the National Secretary of the organisation corresponding with branches on 9 September 2021, drawing their attention to my decision in matter E2021/78. In that decision it was indicated that attempts must be made to fill vacant offices, including those resulting from insufficient nominations being received, and the need for this to occur in a timely manner. In relation to the current matter (E2021/190), I commend the Division's candour in acknowledging its omission of not acting on this vacancy sooner and note its apology in this regard.
- [4] I also take the opportunity to note that if insufficient nominations are received in the election to be arranged for these particular offices (or in future elections), the Commission's clear expectation is that prescribed information would then be lodged by the relevant

organisation, division or branch in a timely manner in an attempt to fill such office(s). I also take this opportunity to commend the organisation's national office on its efforts to address this issue with its divisions and branches.

[5] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

With reference to the above, I attach:

- Prescribed information for an election as required by 189(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act) and Regulation 138 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009;
- AEC Declaration of Result E2018/281

I refer to the correspondence sent to the ROC by the National Secretary, Allen Hicks, on 9 September regarding an insufficent nominations election for this Branch. In his correspondence Mr Hicks noted the decision of the ROC in E2021/78 where in respect of an insufficient nominatons election request by the CEPU Tasmanian Branch, the ROC drew attention to the decision of *Geneff v Peterson and ors* [1986] FCA 432, and the comments of Justice Gray that if insufficent nominations are received in an election, then further elections must be held.

This has prompted the Branch to advise the ROC of an office which was likewise not filled at the previous quadrennial election and for which prescribed information for an insufficient nomination election should also be lodged in an attempt to fill the office.

The office which was not filled at the previous election is as follows:

- BCOM Member Telecommunications & Information Technology Industry Section x 2
- BCOM Member Postal Services Industry Section x 1

Accordingly, the Branch requests that the Registered Organisations Commission arrange an election to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for this position.

Please accept my apology for not acting on this vacancy sooner.
