Other Matters

Returning Officer actions required (Section 193): Yes Details:

- As there is no rule pertaining to the method in which nominations must be lodged, the Returning Officer will apply subparagraph 193(1)(b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to only accept nominations via email or portal and not by hand or post, due to the ongoing COVID-19 risk.
- Rules regarding the timetable of the election were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic may impact on the ability for stakeholders to fully participate in the election. A timetable for the conduct of the ballot which varied from the rules was set when the AEC was satisfied that stakeholders would be able to fully participate
- As there is no rule pertaining to the withdrawal of Nomination, the Returning Officer will apply subparagraph 193(1) (b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to fix a closing time for the withdrawal of nomination and the withdrawal period will align with the close of the nomination period.
- As there is no rule pertaining to the closing time for the submission of the Resume, the Returning Officer will apply subparagraph 193(1) (b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to fix a closing time for the submission of the Resume and the submission period of the Resume will be closed after seven days from the close of the nomination period.
