# Rules

Rules used for the election: 200V: Incorporates alterations of 13 July 2021 [R2021/31] Note: Also includes alterations certified on 11 April 2017 [R2017/2] and 8 May 2019 [R2019/26] which were not included in this rulebook when it was published on 13 July 2021. (replaces rulebook dated 21 June 2021 [R2021/35])

Rules difficult to apply/interpret:

52EG.e.xi.b The full names of candidates, for election for an office shall appear on the ballot paper for that election, shall have been drawn by ballot, at the close of the nominations or, in relation to candidates whose family names are identical, in the alphabetical order of their first or given names

The rule was difficult to apply at close of nominations since the rule does not account for a defect period. Section 143(1) (c) of the Fair Work (RO) Act 2009 mandates that there must be at least a 7 day period to remedy any defects. The order of candidate names can only be drawn after close of nominations and any defect period that may be in effect.

Model Rule reference (if any):

14.1.4 The order of names in each ballot on the ballot paper shall be determined by lot drawn by the returning officer.

# Other Matters

Returning Officer actions required (Section 193): Yes Details:

- Rules regarding the timetable of the election were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic may impact on the ability for stakeholders to fully participate in the election. A timetable for the conduct of the ballot which varied from the rules was set when the AEC was satisfied that stakeholders would be able to fully participate.
- Rules requiring an in-person ballot were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for all stakeholders to attend. Instead the ballot was conducted via post.
- Rules specifying the method of lodgement of nominations were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for potential candidates to nominate. Instead nominations were received electronically, via email/the AEC's portal.
