RE: *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* – Application for s.271 certificate

I am the State Secretary of the Queensland Branch of the Construction, Forestry, Maritime, Mining and Energy Union (CFMMEU). I make this application on behalf of the Branch, pursuant to a direction issued by the National Executive of the CFMMEU and in accordance with Rule 28 of the CFMMEU Rules.


Pursuant to s.271 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act), I hereby apply for a certificate of exemption for the Branch in respect of the financial year ending 31 December 2021.

In support of this application I submit as follows:

1. The CFMMEU consists of a number of Divisions.
2. There exist a number of Divisional Branches, (or in the case of the Mining and Energy Division or Forestry, Furnishing, Building Products and Manufacturing Division, Divisional Districts or District Branches) within these Divisions. Such Divisional Branches, Districts or District Branches function within a designated geographical area, in most cases being the State or Territory in which they are established.
3. The CFMMEU and each Division and Divisional Branch, District or District Branch thereof submit annual financial returns in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Act.
4. CFMMEU State Branches, including the Branch, consist of the members and officers of each Divisional Branch, District or District Branch in each State or Territory.
5. The Branch has not had an account with a bank or any other financial institution nor has it had custody of any real property or monies during the financial year.
6. The Branch had no reason to keep accounting records and did not have any financial affairs during the financial year.

7. The Branch had not traded or carried out financial transactions of any kind and has not expended economic resources or incurred any financial obligations to conduct its activities during the financial year.
8. The various Divisional Branches, Districts, or District Branches within the State of Queensland expend their own economic resources and incur financial obligations so that the Branch may conduct its activities.
9. No person or body corporate or trust expends its own economic resources or incurs financial obligations so that the Branch may conduct its activities.
10. Notwithstanding the above, the Branch has functions in accordance with the rules of the CFMMEU including rules relating to Branches.
