Notification of changes – Action required

We acknowledge receipt of a Notification of Change to the office holders of the Association of Professional Engineers, Scientists and Managers, Australia (AR2022/8).

A list of those changes has been summarised in Appendix A at the end of this letter. The notification of change also gives rise to some issues which we have outlined in detail below.

Organisation's rules regarding terms of office

The first of these issues relates to terms of office. Because the changes notified to the Commission included details of persons being appointed to fill vacant offices, Commission staff undertook a review of your rules regarding terms of office and when someone can be appointed to fill a casual vacancy.

We note that the current Rules relating to the term of office for the office holders that constitute the National Board provides (at Rule 18.12) that office holders "shall take office on the first day of March following election." As you are aware, the most recent election for these offices was declared in August / September 2022. Rule 18.12 also states that office holders "shall continue in office for two years and thereafter until their successors are elected or appointed".

The Commission requests that you could please advise, by Thursday 22 June 2023:

- (a) your organisation's understanding of when its next scheduled election would be due under the rules; and
- (b) whether the organisation's intention for the next term of office is to revert to a situation where officers would take office on the first day of March immediately following the election, i.e. to 're-synchronise' its terms of office.

Your response will assist the Commission in dealing with election-related issues concerning the organisation and in providing advice and assistance regarding them, including whether rule alterations may be required to achieve what the organisation is seeking.

What you need to do now in relation to persons elected to new offices

- Any person who has been elected or appointed to a new office that has financial management duties (which usually includes all the committee of management) MUST do <u>financial training</u> or <u>obtain an</u> <u>exemption</u>
- Inform all officers of their disclosure obligations
- Consider giving your new officers the link to the Commission's Officer Induction Kit

These next steps are explained below in more detail.

Financial training must be done within 6 months

Any officer who has been elected or appointed to a new office that has financial management duties <u>must</u> <u>either complete financial training or obtain an exemption</u> **within 6 months** after taking office (section 293K of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (RO Act)).

The organisation is responsible for this requirement. You should arrange for the relevant officers to have training as soon as possible.

Good governance processes around financial training are highly recommended. These include:

- keeping a list of all offices that have financial management duties
- having a single person or officer responsible for overseeing the process
- collecting records of who has done training or obtained an exemption, including any certificates and exemption letters
- doing refresher courses for officers who have been re-elected to the same office (and are not required to do training under the RO Act)
- extending training to non-officers who are essential to your financial processes



Officer financial training audit

An audit by the Commission into officer training found that organisations frequently misunderstood **which** officers are required to do training.

To help with this we have an <u>officer training online panel</u> with examples explaining what triggers the need to do training and how to identify the offices that require it.

Disclosure obligations: what officers must do

All officers are required to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests. Details are contained in the RO Act and are summarised in the Commission's <u>Disclosures Fact Sheet</u>.

The organisation and officers are both responsible for meeting this obligation.

Time frames for notifications of change

Notifications of change must be lodged within 35 days of the change occurring (regulation 151 *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*).
