Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 19 May 2022 the Australian and International Pilots Association (the **AIPA**) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission (the **Commission**) prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

Committee of Management Members (20)

[2] The Commission notes that the AIPA rules state that nominations are to open 119 days before the second Tuesday in November in the year that an election is to be held. This year that date is 12 July 2022. On this occasion, the prescribed information was not lodged with the Commission two months prior to the date set down in the rules for the opening of nominations, as provided in Regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*.

[3] The rules provide for 40 members of the Committee of Management, with a staggered election cycle whereby these are elected in two elections of 20 Committee members each.¹

[4] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed office is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
