You must take steps after your recent election E2022/150

Dear Melissa Donnelly,

An election has recently been completed by the Australian Electoral Commission (**AEC**) for the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union-PSU Group.

This letter explains the next steps you must take and what information you need to lodge with the Registered Organisations Commission (**ROC**).

What you must do right now

- Let your members know about the election report issued by the AEC
- Arrange financial training for officers newly elected to an office with financial management duties. (This includes all members of the committee of management).
- Complete the notification of change and email it to regorgs@roc.gov.au

This letter explains these steps and the tools available to help you.

STEP 1: Notify members

You must put a notice on your website once you receive your post-election report. It must tell your members they can request a copy of the post-election report from you or the AEC (r. 141). The notice must be on your website for at least 3 months.



Can I put more information on our website?

Yes! Being transparent is part of good governance. You can publish the whole report or the declaration of results, as well as your notice and leave them up longer than 3 months. You can always do more than the regulatory minimum.

The ROC will also publish your declaration of results on our website.

STEP 2: Financial training

You may have to arrange financial training for people elected to new roles.

All officers with financial management duties must complete financial training (s 293K). For information on when officers must redo training and hints on when to book training for officers taking up multiple offices please see our fact sheet.

There are face to face and online financial training packages on the ROC website.

You must act on this now, as affected officers MUST complete approved financial training OR been granted an exemption by the ROC within 6 months of beginning to hold office.



Good governance tip:

Organisations should instruct officer holders about their other obligations. This is especially important for committee of management members.

Our podcast covers the <u>benefits of officer induction</u>. Officers have responsibilities under the rules, the RO Act, and disclosure requirements around conflicts of interest, remuneration and material personal interests. Officers will benefit from our <u>officer induction kit</u> and our <u>podcast</u>, <u>such as episode 17 - conflicts of interest</u>.

STEP 3: Notifications of change

A notification of change must be lodged with the ROC within 35 days of the change occurring.



We have a <u>template</u> to help you with this, which you can send to <u>regorgs@roc.gov.au</u>. An officer must sign the completed notification template.

You must lodge a notification of change if:

- any of your officers have not been re-elected;
- officers have changed offices; or
- you have new officers.

Only notify us of changes that have **already occurred**. If people take up office in the future, you must wait until the change happens before lodging the notification within 35 days of the change.

Note: One election may result in many notifications of change.



Penalties apply

Failing to lodge your notifications of change on time can expose your organisation and its officers to significant penalties.

ROC v CEPU

The organisation failed to make a series of notifications of change on time.

The Full Court said 'The record-keeping obligations imposed under the Registered Organisations Act are treated by the legislature as important and serious, and contravention of those obligations are correspondingly serious.'

The organisation was ordered to pay a penalty. More information is available in our <u>case summary</u>.

Why do I need to tell you the results of the election when you've already received them?

The RO Act requires that **you** tell us this information about your officers – it is a legal obligation. The notification of change also contains information that is not in the declaration of results.

What if the officer has already done training?

Check out our <u>fact sheet</u> for when officers need to redo training, when they can get an exemption and when further training isn't required.

DECISION

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union (E2022/150)

MR STEENSON

SYDNEY, 4 AUGUST 2022

Arrangement for conduct of election.

- [1] On 7 July and 3 August 2022 the PSU Group of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union (the **Organisation**) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission (the **Commission**) prescribed information for an election to fill offices and non-office positions, due to insufficient nominations in a previous election (**E2021/148**) and casual vacancies, as well as new offices created as a result of recent rule alterations (**R2021/223**) as outlined in paragraph [3] below. All are for the remainder of the current term of office.
- [2] Of the vacancies referred to in paragraph [1], five offices and 12 non-office positions are casual vacancies. The casual vacancies of Section Secretaries arose in the following sections: Attorney Generals; Foreign Affairs, Aid and Trade; Telstra; and the Infrastructure, Intellectual Property and Communications sections. One casual vacancy for Governing Councillor arose in the Services Australia, Victoria Section.
- [3] The casual vacancies for the non-office positions of Section Councillor arose in the following sections: Attorney Generals Section AGD Heritage (2 positions) and AGS (1 position); Education, Skills and Employment Australian Capital Territory (1 position); Defence Defence, Science and Technology Group (1 position) and Capability Acquisition and Sustainment Group (1 position); Services Australia New South Wales (1 position), South Australia (1 position), Western Australia (1 position) and Victoria (2 positions); and one casual vacancy for the non-office position of Section Deputy President in the Food Inspectorial Section.
- [4] As part of its prescribed information, the organisation lodged a copy of a recent decision of the Fair Work Commission [2022] FWCG 26 in matter R2021/223 certifying alterations to the organisation's rules. Among other things, the alterations to sub-rule 1.2 provide for the composition of the CPSU's Governing Council. Previously, sections required a minimum of 2,000 members before being eligible to elect a Governing Councillors from their section; this has reduced to 1,000. There is also an entitlement to an additional Governing Councillor for each additional 1,000 members thereafter. Consequently a number of additional Governing Councillors are now attached to different sections, those being the ACT Government, Home Affairs, Defence, National Disability Insurance, NT Public Service, Agriculture, Water and Environment and Tax.
- [5] The offices and non-office positions are set out in **Attachment A**.

[6] I am satisfied that an election for the **office and non-office positions** set out in Attachment A is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.




