UCIW ANNUAL RETURN OF INFORMATION (organisation with no branches) in accordance with Regulations 147Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 and Sections 230 and 233 Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

- I, Gordon Thomson, being the General Secretary, of the Union of Christmas Island Workers state:
- 1. I am authorised to make this declaration.
- 2. The register of members has, during the immediately preceding calendar year, been kept and maintained as required by s.230(1)(a) and s.230(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act* 2009 (the Act).
- 3. The following is a correct statement of the information contained in the records required to be kept by the organisation in accordance with s.230(1)(b), (c), and (d) of the Act:
 - o The address of the organisation is 61 Poon Saan Road Christmas Island. ¹
 - The organisation has no branches and no branches have ceased or commenced in the previous 12 months.²
 - On 31 December in the previous year the number of members was 202, of which 173 were financial on 31 December 2022.³
 - A list of offices and the names, postal addresses and occupations of persons holding those
 offices as at the date of this declaration is attached at **Annexure A** and forms part of this
 declaration.
 - No elections are due this year 1 January to 31 December 2023.
 - O Under the rules of the organisation, an election for all members of the UCIW Executive Committee was due in 2020. An application was made to the ROC which approved the application for the 2020 election [E2020/163]. Due to COVID restrictions and reduced capacity of the Australian Electoral Commission, the timetable of actions for the election commenced on 28 March 2022 with the publication of the notice of election by the Returning Officer, Australian Electoral Commission.
