*Arrangement for conduct of election.*

[1] On 7 March 2024, the Victorian Showmen's Guild (organisation) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

President	(1)
Vice-Presidents	(10)
Committee Members	(9)
Secretary	(1)
Treasurer	(1)
Trustees	(2)

[2] In relation to the election of the Committee Members, the candidates receiving the ten highest number of votes shall, in accordance with rules 16.4.1 and 16.7 of the organisation's rules, be declared elected as Vice Presidents. The candidates for Committee Members receiving the next nine highest number of votes shall be declared elected as Committee Members.<sup>1</sup>

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
