RE: APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 271 OF THE FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) ACT 2009

The Local Government, Racing and Cemeteries Employees Union, makes application pursuant to Section 271 of the Act and Regulation 165 of the Regulations for exemption from financial reporting for the financial reporting period ending 30 June 2024 for the following reasons:

- A) The reporting unit has not expended economic resources, nor has it incurred any financial obligations to conduct its activities; and
- B) The State Counterpart Organisation known as the Local Government, Racing and Cemeteries Employees Union (WA) has expended all necessary economic resources and incurred financial obligations so that the Federal Reporting Unit could conduct its activities for the reporting period ending 30 June 2024.
- C) The above conditions in A) have applied in respect of previous reporting periods, however the former WA Division of the Reporting with respect to the former WA Division Reporting Unit, undertook functions that the State Counterpart Organisation now performs.
- D) With the reorganisation of the Federal Union and its State Counterpart which took effect from 1 July 2023 the above conditions in A) and B applied from 1 July 2023.
- E) The reporting unit does not employee staff directly, maintain a bank account, hold money in cash and has not been issued with a corporate credit card.

We look forward to the Commission's consideration of this request. Should the Commission require further and better particulars with respect to this application we await those instructions.
