Arrangement for conduct of election.

- [1] The decision issued by the Delegate of the General Manager of the Fair Work Commission (the **Commission**) on 9 October 2024 [2024] FWCD 125 requires amendment.
- [2] On 16 September 2024, the Tasmanian Hospitality Association (the **Branch**) of the Australian Hotels Association lodged prescribed information for an election to fill Branch offices for a new term of office. This gave rise to the election decision dated 9 October 2024.
- [3] Prior to the prescribed information being lodged, on 28 August 2024 the Branch had also lodged with the Commission an application for alteration of its rules (**R2024/125**). The rule alterations were certified on 25 October 2024, i.e. after the election decision was issued, and those alterations affect the offices to be filled in this election **E2024/158**.
- [4] Relevantly, alterations to sub-rules 14(a)(ii)(b) and 14(a)(iii)(b) have created an additional Representative to State Council for the Accommodation Hotels Division, increasing the number from two (2) to three (3) representatives. Transitional rule 34(a)(ii) provides that the third Accommodation Hotel Division Representative shall take office at the declaration of the 2024 election.
- [5] In addition, an alteration to sub-rule 19(f) has the effect of reserving the office of the Branch Senior Vice President such that it becomes an office held 'ex officio' by the President of the Pub/Tavern Division. (Previously under the rules it was also an ex officio Branch Vice President, as it now remains for the other Divisions).
- [6] On 25 October 2024 staff of the Commission requested the Branch to lodge amending prescribed information to reflect the changes put into effect by the new Branch rules. Amending prescribed information was lodged on 28 October and 1 November 2024.
- [7] For abundant clarity, this amending decision [2024] FWCD 125 PR755364 entirely replaces the 9 October 2024 election decision.¹

- [2] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act* 2009 (**RO Act**), I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission (**AEC**).
- [3] I note that the AEC, in its post-election report for the previous election (E2023/165), stated that it found Branch rule 14(j)(V) difficult to interpret and apply, and that the Branch should allow a minimum of 28 days for a postal ballot recommending that the Branch consider a rule change accordingly. Section 198 of the RO Act requires that an organisation or branch must respond, within 30 days, to a report by the AEC that it found a rule difficult to apply or interpret.
- [4] On 28 August 2024, the Branch lodged with the Commission an application for alteration of its rules, which relevantly includes a proposed alteration to Branch rule 14(j)(V) such that it would specify at least 28 days for a postal ballot. The Commission's Rules team is currently assessing the Branch's rule alteration and using its best endeavours to progress a decision on the rule alterations be made before the commencement of the Branch's election process.
- [5] I request that the AEC take into account this pending rule alteration when engaging with the Branch about the timetable for this forthcoming election. In the event that the relevant rule alterations are certified, the Commission will immediately notify the AEC and the Branch.
