Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 22 November 2024 the Australian Licenced Aircraft Engineers Association (the Association) lodged with the Fair Work Commission (Commission) prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for the remainder of the term:

[2] The first listed office is vacant due to insufficient nominations received in the previous scheduled election E2022/5¹ and in subsequent elections E2022/170² and E2023/164³ which attempted to fill it. Both offices listed above were then the subject of insufficient nominations in the Association's most recent election E2024/148⁴.

[3] Further to the above offices, the Association also included in the prescribed information a request for an election to fill a casual vacancy in the following office, for the remainder of the term:


