[1] On 19 December 2024 the Civil Air Operations Officers' Association of Australia (**organisation**) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

Nominations close in accordance with a timetable provided by the Returning Officer, delegated by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) - for the positions marked "A", refer to Civil Air rule 33(f)(i).

### Cut off date for roll:

In all cases, 7 days prior to the opening date for nominations.
