Reasons for election:

 Election for offices and positions marked above is required as the terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

Elected by:

• The electorate for the direct voting system is the whole of the national organisation.

Nominations open:

For offices to be elected by direct voting system - the 1st day of August 2025.

Nominations close:

 For offices to be elected by direct voting system - 12 noon, on the 21st day after nominations have opened, being the 22nd day of August 2025.

Cut off date for roll:

In all cases - thirty (30) days prior to the opening date for nominations, being the 2nd day of July 2025 (rule 16.10.6).
