Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 5 May 2025 the Motor Trade Association of South Australia Incorporated lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

[2] Under the organisation’s rules, there are seven (7) Board members, each elected for a two-year term – three (3) of whom are elected in one year and four (4) are elected the next year. The election for Chair and Deputy Chair is an annual election by and from the Board Members.¹

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.


