*Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

**Master Builders Association of South Australia Incorporated** (E2025/101)

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 20 June 2025 the Master Builders Association of South Australia Incorporated (the organisation) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

[2] In the organisation's rules it is referred to as 'the Association'. Rule 11(4) of the organisation's rules defines 'Past President' as: '[a] previous office bearer of the Association who has completed a term of office as President'.<sup>1</sup> Given this definition, the role is <u>not</u> confined to the Immediate Past President (ex office) but is open to any person who has served a complete term as President to nominate for the office of Past President.

[3] The rules also require that nomination forms be provided to financial members at least four (4) weeks prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM). This year, the AGM is scheduled

for 22 October 2025 and the organisation has expressed a preference for nomination forms to be made available at least five (5) weeks prior to the AGM.

[4] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
