Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 16 June 2025 the Timber Trade Industrial Association (the **Association**) lodged prescribed information, and on 1 July 2025 lodged amended prescribed information, with the Fair Work Commission for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:
