Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

United Firefighters' Union of Australia (E2025/131)

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 8 August 2025, the Australian Capital Territory Branch (the **Branch**) of the United Firefighters' Association of Australia (the **UFUA**) lodged with the Fair Work Commission (the **Commission**) prescribed information for an election to fill a newly created office on the Branch Committee of Management (**BCOM**), for the remainder of the term.

- [2] Other offices of the BCOM were most recently elected in the scheduled election E2024/12,¹ which was declared by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) on 4 April 2024.
- [3] The rules of each of the UFUA's branches appear as Schedules to the UFUA rules. On 9 May 2025, the Branch lodged with the Commission a notice and declaration setting out proposed alterations to Schedule 7 of the UFUA rules, which contains the ACT Branch's rules.
- [4] The alterations, which were certified on 3 July 2025,² insert within the Branch rules, a new subrule 1(a)(iii) which provides for an additional Trustee office on the BCOM. Another new subrule, 1(b)(i), provides that the new Firefighter Trustee office is to be held by a person who holds a rank below the rank of Station Officer.
- [5] In support of the rule alteration, the Branch provided submissions (that the Commission accepted), which stated that:

'[ACT Fire & Rescue] currently has 396 operational firefighter positions, 296 of those 396 positions are occupied by firefighters who are a rank below the rank of Station Officer. The BCOM currently has 8 positions, of which only 2 of those are held by firefighters who are a rank below the rank of Station Officer.

The proposed change is intended to ensure that our committee better represents all firefighters, particularly those who are beginning their career and ensuring that we reflect a voice for those newer firefighters.'

- [6] The rule alterations also provide, in subrule 1(c), that the additional office of Trustee is to be elected as soon as practicable after the rule creating it has been certified, and that the person declared elected shall hold office from the date that this election (E2025/131) is declared until the declaration of the next scheduled election for the BCOM, which is to be conducted in 2027.⁴
- [7] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed office is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
