Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 15 September 2025, the Real Estate Employers' Federation (**REEF**) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

- [2] Under the REEF rules, the election is a two-stage process: Committee Members being elected, then an election of the senior offices by and from those elected Committee Members.¹
- [3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
