Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 13 November 2025, the Newcastle, Northern, South Australian and Tasmanian Branch (the **Branch**) of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union (the **organisation**) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information and on 20 November 2025 lodged amended prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

Restructure of Branches

[2] Since the previous scheduled election for what was then the Newcastle and Northern Branch in (E2021/72)¹, there have been two separate certifications of alterations to the organisation's rules under section 159 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

- (RO Act) that have changed the Branch's structure.² Among other things, the Tasmanian Branch has been dissolved and its members reallocated to the Newcastle and Northern Branch, renaming it the Newcastle, Northern and Tasmanian Branch (NNT Branch).³ Separately, the South and Western Australian Branch was dissolved and the members in South Australia reallocated to the NNT Branch, which has been renamed and now bears the name set out in the first paragraph of this decision.
- [3] The restructure reflected in the rule changes has altered the composition of the Branch's Committee of Management by creating two new representative positions reserved for members in South Australia and reducing the number of representative positions reserved for members in Tasmania from two to one.⁴ The remaining seven Branch Committee members elected by the New South Wales membership of the Branch remains unchanged from the previous election.⁵
- [4] The alterations also reduce the Branch's entitlement to Federal Council Delegates representing the Branch on the Federal Council, from four positions to three positions.⁶ It is noted that the rules certified in (R2022/114)⁷, provided that two Federal Council Delegate positions were to be reserved for delegates elected by members based in Tasmania, therefore entitling the Branch to a total of four Federal Council Delegates. Subsequent rule alterations certified in (R2024/71) removed the Tasmanian Branch's guaranteed entitlement with the effect of reducing the total number of Branch Federal Council Delegate positions from four to three.⁸
- [5] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the RO Act, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
