Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 5 November 2025 the Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices, due to insufficient nominations received in a previous election (E2023/203):

[2] The organisation has also advised that it is not seeking to fill some vacant offices, by virtue of rule 57(10) of the organisation's rules. The organisation has provided relevant supporting information. Rule 57(10) relevantly provides that:

Where a Branch has no members employed in a Practitioner Type at the opening of nominations for the election of the Branch Councillors, then the office of that respective Practitioner Type will remain vacant ... [for the remainder of its term].

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS in accordance with Section 189 Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and Regulation 138 Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009

I, Dr Stuart Day, being the Federal Secretary of the Australian Salaried Medical Officers Federation (the Federation) make the following statement:
