Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 3 December 2025, the Western Australian Branch (the Branch) of the Australian Education Union lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill casual vacancies in the following office for the remainder of the term:

> Members of Branch Council from the Victoria Park District **(2)**

- [2] For casual vacancies that arise among Branch Council members elected from Districts, Branch rule 2(5)(a) provides that 'vacancies ... where more than half of the term of office remains unexpired, shall be filled by ... conducting an election.' Each of the officers, whose resignations in November 2025 created the above casual vacancies, were elected in **E2024/123**, ¹ commencing their two-year term of office on 20 March 2025.² As the term is due to expire on 19 March 2027, more than half of the term remains unexpired and, therefore, the vacancies must be filled via an election.
- I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the AEC.
