The Australian Institute of Marine and Power Engineers - Queensland Branch's Officer and Related Party Disclosure Statement (ORP Statement)

Thank you for providing your ORP Statement. Your ORP Statement includes information required to be provided to your members and lodged under subsection 293J of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act).

### Assessment of ORP Statement

Your ORP Statement has been assessed. As indicated above, it was submitted late, contrary to section 293J of the RO Act.

### Time frames

Section 293J requires that the ORP statement must be provided to members and lodged with the Commission within 6 months of the end of the organisation's financial year. That is, by 31 December for an organisation with a 30 June financial year. Section 293J is a civil penalty provision and non-compliance (whether non-lodgement or late lodgement) may expose an organisation to Federal Court proceedings and penalties.

In the case of your Branch, the ORP Statement for the 2024/2025 financial year was lodged more than 6 months after the end of that financial year.

### Communication from the Branch regarding late lodgement

It is understood that the late lodgement occurred following technical issues experienced by Branch staff. On 7 January 2026, a Branch employee advised Commission staff that there had been issues with emails in December 2025, and that this likely led to the ORP statement not being received by the Commission. On 7 January 2026, the Branch lodged the ORP statement with the Commission via email. The email attaching the ORP statement

also included a chain of internal emails. The internal emails demonstrated that the Branch President had signed the ORP statement on 17 December 2025 (which is also indicated by the date of the signature on the ORP statement) and provided it to an internal staff member for lodgement. While there was no evidence of an attempted email from the Branch to the Commission around this time, Branch staff have advised that the email issues likely affected the apparent sending of the ORP statement to the Commission.

Regardless of the apparent issues outlined above, the failure of the Branch to comply with the requirements of section 293J has been noted.

### **Future lodgements**

The Branch should be aware that the email for lodgements ([regorgs@fwc.gov.au](mailto:regorgs@fwc.gov.au)) has an 'auto reply' function. When an email is received in the Inbox, an auto reply is sent confirming that the email has been received.

As such, for all future lodgements, the Branch should take note of this auto reply email as confirmation that the email has been received by the Commission.

Further, the Commission has information and education materials available on our [website](#) including fact sheets, webinars, templates and other materials regarding ORP statements. These materials are regularly updated. We recommend the Branch familiarises itself with its statutory requirements and [subscribes to the Commission's subscription service](#).

The ORP Statement has now been filed.
