Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 19 March 2026, the Queensland Together Branch (the **Branch**) of the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (the **ASU**) lodged prescribed information, and on 26 March 2026 lodged amended prescribed information, with the Fair Work Commission seeking an election to fill casual vacancies in the following offices for the remainder of the term:

[2] Under the rules of the organisation, the abovenamed offices are elected via a direct voting system election, whereby the members in the particular Sub-Division or Regional Zone elect their representatives(s). There are other Branch offices which are elected by and from other officers (known as a ‘collegiate’ election).

[3] Whereas the abovenamed offices will be the subject of an election, the Branch has indicated in the prescribed information that its Executive has resolved to have the offices

requiring a collegiate election to be filled via appointment, in accordance with rule 78 d. of the organisation's rules, which deals with the method of filling casual vacancies where more than 12 months of the term has elapsed.

[4] The terms of all offices (which were the subject of scheduled election E2023/35 at the start of the term) run until 2027, when the next quadrennial election is due under the rules.¹

[5] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.


