*Arrangement for conduct of election.*

[1] On 30 March 2026, the Australasian Convenience and Petroleum Marketers Association (the **organisation**) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

Board of Management Representative NSW Region	(1)
Board of Management Representative SA/Tas Region	(1)
Board of Management Representative National Region	(1)
National President	(1)
National Treasurer	(1)

[2] I note that all of the offices requested for election in this matter (including those of President and Treasurer) have reached the end of their terms. Therefore, an election for the offices of President and Treasurer will be required, regardless of whether the incumbents are re-elected to a Board of Management office in Stage 1 of this election.

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

**RE: Prescribed information relating to elections to be held during the year 2025 in accordance with the Rules of the organisation**

We wish to supply Prescribed information in regards to the elections for regional representation in this organisation and scheduled collegiate elections for office bearers.

Please Note;

- The following positions are due for election for a two-year term. The reason for the elections is that the term of each incumbent is due to expire at the time of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) for the organisation:

**Board of Management Representative (1) for New South Wales Region**  
**Board of Management Representative (1) for South Australia and Tasmania Region**  
**Board of Management Representative (1) for National Region**

Collegiate Election for Officer if required due to current officer not being returned;  
**National President (1)**

- These elections are conducted under the direct voting system.
- Under the rules, nominations for regional representatives, as defined above, must be called not less than 50 days in advance of the date fixed for the AGM, and close no later than 30 days from the date of the AGM (Rule 62.A).
- Under the Rules, the roll of voters for the ballot shall close 7 days prior to the day on which nominations open (Rule 62.C.i).
- Under the Rules, the Returning Officer Is the Australian Electoral Commission.
- The date scheduled for the AGM is 25 November 2026 in Melbourne and via Video Conference.

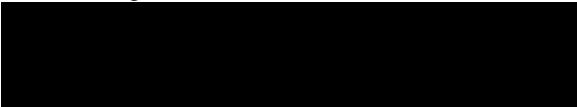
