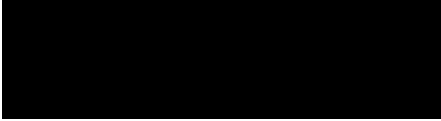
**PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS in accordance with Section 189
