Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 3 June 2026 the Northern Territory Branch of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation (ANMF) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

[2] Rule 83 of the ANMF rules provides that these Branch offices are elected every second year,¹ with the most recent election being E2024/98, declared on 23 September 2024.

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

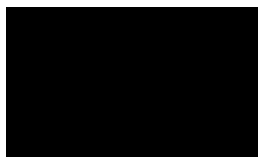
I, Heidi Crisp, being the Branch Secretary of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Northern Territory Branch make the following statement:
