Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 16 July 2026 the Breweries and Bottleyards Employees' Industrial Union of Workers of Western Australia lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

[2] Under the rules of the organisation, the offices of Secretary and Treasurer are elected for a four-year term;¹ other offices the subject of this election are elected for a two-year term.²

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

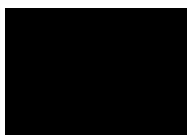
