Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 7 July 2026 the Western Australian Branch (**Branch**) of the Australian Education Union (**AEU**) lodged with the Fair Work Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices for a new term of office:

Members of Branch Council (numbers to be determined in accordance with the Rules) from the following Districts:

Belmont
Bunbury
Butler
Fremantle
Goldfields
Hillarys
Jandakot
Kalamunda
Kimberley-Pilbara
Maylands
Moore
Morley
Murray
Perth
Riverton
Rockingham
Scarborough
Stirling
Swan
Victoria Park

[2] Rule 2(1)(b) of the AEU Western Australian Branch Rules¹ provides that, in relation to the members of Branch Council, the number to be elected from each district is one delegate for every 100 members, or part thereof, in that district. The date for the calculation of district entitlements is *‘the final gazetted date of the school year ending immediately prior to the conduct of the election of Branch Councillors’*. In relation to this election the final gazetted day of the 2026 school year is 17 December 2026.

[3] As the prescribed information was lodged by the Branch before this date, the specific number of delegates to be elected from each district could not be specified at the time of lodgement. Nor can it be specified at the time of issuing this decision.

[4] Branch rule 2(3) provides that the new term of office shall commence on 20 March following the election, that is 20 March 2027. Branch rule 9(1) provides that *‘Each District shall elect representatives to Branch Council (i.e. Members of Branch Council) every two years, during the first school division term’*. This suggests that nominations would ordinarily open at the beginning of the 2027 school term.

[5] The prescribed information advises that the precise date for opening of nominations is to be determined by the Returning Officer. Given that the number of representatives will be calculated based on membership as at a date in December 2026, it is reasonably anticipated that the precise number of Branch Councillors for each district will be ascertained in advance of the call for nominations by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) as, in practical terms, this needs to be identified for the election to proceed.

[6] Additionally, Branch rule 9(2) provides that, where sufficient nominations have been received from women financial members, at least 50 per cent of Branch Councillors shall be women. Branch rule 9(3) further provides that, where fewer than the number of nominations required for Branch rule 9(2) are received from women, any woman who so nominated shall be declared elected.

[7] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the AEC.

- Financial members whose place of work is within the same specified district as that of the elected delegates.

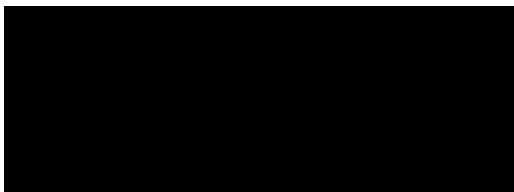

The number of Branch Council members for each district shall be determined in accordance with Federal branch Rule 2 (1)(b).

The voting system is by direct election. Under Rule 13 (9A), the roll of voters for any election is to be closed seven days before the day on which nominations are opened. Under Rule 9 (8), nominations for election to Branch Council shall be called at least fourteen days prior to the date on which nominations close.

The dates and times that nominations close are to be fixed by the Returning Officer pursuant to the Rules.
