In relation to the vacancy said to arise from Mr Mark Stevens' unemployment status, it seems to me that Mr Stevens must be given an opportunity to respond (say on 7 day's notice) to the issue of his cessation from office on the basis of his unemployment. While it appears that the union has advised Mr Stevens of the union's policy on unemployment and his conditional exemption from paying fees, the union does not appear to have advised Mr Stevens that his position is vacant. I believe there is an implied requirement that Mr Stevens be notified by the union that his position is considered to be vacant.

A similar issue arose in relation to the previous election notification (E2003/254) - see my letter of 3 September 2003 at Attachment A.

If the union undertakes the notice procedure outlined above for Mr Stevens and if he either does not respond, or, in the alternative, concurs with the union's position, then I will be prepared to make arrangements for an election to fill the vacancy.

It appears that there is time for this process to be finalised prior to the issuing of the complete election decision. In the alternative, an election decision for all other vacant positions can be issued within a week, with Mr Stevens' position deferred until further information is received.

Election for 7 casual vacancies - Victorian State Conference Delegates (Metals) - E2003/254

I refer to your notification for an election for seven casual vacancies which was lodged in the industrial Registry on 11 August 2003. I also refer to your letter of 22 August 2003 in which you make submissions in relation to the construction and operation of the rules of the union with respect to the particular vacant positions.

The seven casual vacancles are said to arise in the following circumstances:

- 3 vacancies due to resignations (Barnes, Light and Rogers)
- · 2 vacancies due to unfinanciality (Bell and Sutcliffs)
- 2 vacancies due to living and working interstate (Rodwell and Rattigan)

The three vacancies arising from the resignations - in respect of which the organisation has provided copies of the respective letters of resignation - are not in issue. I am satisfied that such vacancies exist.

In relation to the vacancies said to arise from unfinanciality it seems to me that the two individuals must be given an opportunity to respond (say on 7 day's notice) on the issue of their cessation from office on the basis of their unfinanciality. While I agree that the provisions of rule 13 may not be applicable in their entirety to the present circumstances I believe there is an implied requirement that the two persons be *notified* by the union that their positions are considered to be vacant. The giving of notice seems to me to meet the minimalist process that in my view is a limitation on the power of the State Council to determine the cessation of office in the particular circumstances.

The issue of implied limitations into the operation of rules of organisations was analysed by Gray J in *Scott v Jess* (1984) 3 FCR 263 at 284 in the following terms:

"The difficulty of implying terms into the rules of an organisation does not, however, mean that such rules are to be construed as if no implication whatever arises from them. In many respects, there are to be derived from the express terms of the rules, the terms of the Act and the Regulations, and the nature, function and purpose of the organisation concerned, implications which limit what might

otherwise be the extent of the express terms of the rules. The most obvious example is that powers given by the rules of organisations to inflict penalties on members are construed as being subject to the implication that such powers will not be exercised without adherence to the principles of natural justice. The implication of the requirements of natural justice is so well established that it is unnecessary to cite authority. Porter v. Dugmore, supra, was itself a case in which both Northrop J. and the Full Court held that there existed an implied limitation on the powers of the governing body of an organisation, preventing the institution of a system requiring members of the organisation to possess 'OK' cards distributed by the organisation in order that those members could obtain employment.

In such cases, it is not possible to point to any specific provision of the rules the performance or observance of which is being ordered or directed. In a real sense, the court is ordering or directing the performance and observance of the rules of the organisation concerned as a whole, the impugned act being regarded as a departure from the overall scheme of such rules. At all events, the jurisdiction of the court in such cases seems to be so well established that it is too late to attempt to overturn it."


The position that the two persons who are apparently living and working interstate being ineligible to continue to hold office is not free from doubt, however I am prepared to accept the union's construction on the effect of local residency as a condition precedent to the right to hold office. Nevertheless, as with the persons' ineligible for unfinanciality, I believe that notice must be given to Messrs Rodwell and Rattigan at their last known address to provide such persons with an opportunity to respond.

If the union undertakes the notice procedure outlined above in respect of the persons who it is claimed no longer hold office due to unfinanciality or non residence, and such individuals either do not respond, or in the alternative concur with the union's position, then I will be prepared to make arrangements for an election to fill such vacancies. In relation to the resigned positions, I can either make the arrangements now, or wait until the issue with the remaining vacancies becomes clear.





Following a National Council decision, effective from 1st April 1984, unemployed AMWU members do not have to pay contributions to remain members of the Union.

How the scheme works

Your dues are suspended from the day you notified the Union of your unemployment. Any necessary adjustments to your financial position will be made when you obtain employment.

What to do when re-employed

When you obtain employment, go to an AMWU State or Regional Office and your account will be adjusted to cover the period of unemployment. You will be issued a current membership card, showing your correct financial position.

Duration of scheme

A National Conference decision effective 1st October 1992 states that unemployed members will be granted exemption from Union dues for 12 months. Should an unemployed member wish to remain in the Union beyond 12 months, an application should be made to your Regional or State Office.


