[2] Election rules of the organisation

While I am making arrangements for an election to fill the abovenamed offices I note that a number of possible ambiguities in the rules of the organisation became apparent during the consideration of this matter. I refer in particular to Rule 5 which concerns the composition of, and elections for, the National Conference.

[3] Rule 5.4(b)(i) currently provides that:

Subject to subparagraph (ii) below¹, in conducting elections to the National Conferences of the Divisions other than the Technical, Supervisory and Administrative Division, and in conducting elections for Technical, Supervisory and Administrative Division delegates to the National Conference, in accordance with the provisions of rule 53, the State Returning Officer shall determine the entitlement of a Region of a Division to National Conference on the basis of one delegate for each 3,000 members or part thereof of the Region of the Division concerned, as at the last day of the previous quarter preceding the determination.

[4] The meaning of Rule 5.4(b)(i) is unclear.

[5] It would appear that the reference in Rule 5.4(b)(i) to “*elections to the National Conferences of the Divisions*” may be intended to refer to “*elections to the National Conference*” because the formula in Rule 5.4(b)(i) appears to only relate to delegates of the National Conference².

[6] If that is the case then the references in Rule 5.4(b)(i) to the Technical, Supervisory and Administrative Division would appear to be redundant because Rule 50.17 and Part D of Rule 53 already include relevant provisions relating to this Division.

¹ Rule 5.4(b)(ii) provides that for the purposes of elections of delegates to National Conference from the Technical, Supervisory and Administrative Division the membership figures for the NSW and Queensland Regions shall not include members who work in the ACT and the NT respectively.

² The formulae that relate to the delegates of the National Conferences of the Divisions are set out separately in Rules 50.13 to 50.17.

[7] Consequently, Rule 5.4(b)(i) would read as follows if the abovementioned amendments were made:

Subject to subparagraph (ii) below, in conducting elections to the National Conference in accordance with the provisions of rule 53, the State Returning Officer shall determine the entitlement of a Region of a Division to National Conference on the basis of one delegate for each 3,000 members or part thereof of the Region of the Division concerned, as at the last day of the previous quarter preceding the determination.

[8] The meaning of Rules 5.4(c)(iii) – (v) also appear to be unclear. These rules relate to the conduct of elections for additional delegate(s) to the National Conference where there are insufficient delegates to the relevant National Conferences of the Divisions to fill those positions (as dual offices).

[9] I encourage the organisation to take action to remedy these apparent ambiguities in its Rules.

[10] The Registry can provide further information to the organisation regarding these matters. In addition, the Registry can provide comment regarding any draft rules the organisation may wish to submit in the Registry to address these issues.

[11] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of Schedule 1 of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

AMWU members from across all Divisions have participated in the national Day of Protest of 30th November, 2006.

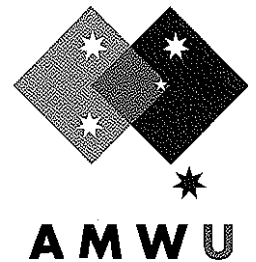
The Melbourne rally took on a different look this time round with the MCG being the central meeting of focal point.
