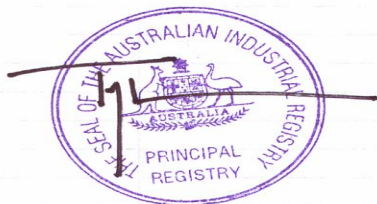

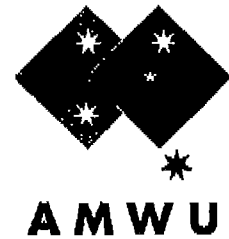

5 SEPTEMBER, 2008**

Council further notes that, in the event that SA Metals was reduced to three officials in 2009 due to the budget position at that time, all three remaining positions would be elected positions. This does not provide the flexibility necessary to meet potential future developments and therefore, consistent with past practice, Council resolves that the number of elected positions be reduced from three to two. Council determines that the Registrar be advised that the position be suspended from 30 June 2009 and not proceed to election.
