I can advise as follows:

NSW Print.

Please note that the two organiser positions referred to have been abolished by two separate resolutions of the Union's National Council.

The first was abolished by resolution of the Council on 26 September, 2006. While it is our usual practice to advise the Registrar of such resolutions, I have been unable to locate any such correspondence. I therefore attach an extract of the minutes of that meeting where the decision was taken.

The second position was abolished by resolution of the Council in September, 2008 and I attach a copy of correspondence to the Registrar of 30 September 2008 advising of that fact.

TSA Tasmania

Sub-paragraph 23.3(a)(ii) of the union's rules provides that each Division in Tasmania is entitled to one delegate to State Conference for each 250 members;

I can advise that the Tasmanian TSA Division had 151 members at 31/12/08 and, therefore, a State Conference Delegate entitlement of one.

Please note also that sub-rule 52.11 provides that the TSA Division's Regional Presidents must be a delegate to State Conference.

Therefore, there is no need for an election for a Tasmanian State Conference delegate as the one position available to the Division is to be filled by the Regional President.

I acknowledge receipt of the prescribed information signed by Dave Oliver, the National Secretary submitted pursuant to s189 for the Registrar to arrange for the conduct of the elections by the AEC. The prescribed information was lodged in the Registry on 2 March 2009 (E2009/124).

I also acknowledge that elections are required according to the AMWU rules for all the offices contained in the prescribed information lodged on 2 March 2009. However I have two queries in relation to two possible offices that may be due for an election according to the AMWU rules but were not included in the prescribed information of E2009/124.

1. In the **New South Wales – Printing Division, State Organisers (2)** were up for election in E2005/72 but no such request was contained in the prescribed information in E2009/124. I note rule 50(28)(e) provides that each Regional Council of the Printing Division shall consist of such number of State Organisers – Printing Division as may be determined by State Conference in accordance with rule 27, and rule 53, Part "C", (11)(d) specifies the State Organiser's term of office is 4 years. Can you please provide the Registry with further information in relation to why this office of the State Organisers (2) from the NSW – Printing Division is not due for an election?

2. In the **Tasmania – Technical, Supervisor and Administrative Division, Delegates to the State Conference** (number to be determined) were not contained in the prescribed information in E2009/124. I note this office carries a 4 year term according to rule 53, Part "F" (25)(d) of the rules and the last election for this office was in E2005/72. I also note this office still exists according to rule 23(2)(c) of the rules. Furthermore, the prescribed information in E2009/124 has included this equivalent office for Victoria, NSW, ACT, Queensland, South Australia and Western Australia but not Tasmania. Can you please provide the Registry with further information as to why the Tasmanian – Technical, Supervisor and Administrative Division, State Conference Delegates are not due for an election?



Council notes that the Print Regions of NSW and Victoria, and Metals South Australia, had significant deficits following preparation of the budget for 2006/7.


Council adopts the NABC recommendation that one Organiser from each area be converted to a fixed term, delegation position


