SUPPORTING STATEMENT

I, Dave Oliver, of 251 Queensberry Street, Carlton South, in the State of Victoria, union official, state as follows:

1. I am the National Secretary of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU), an organisation of employees registered under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act).
2. I am authorised to lodge the information prescribed by regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*.
3. By a decision of the Delegate of the General Manager on 15 April 2011 ([2011] FWAD 1798), the rules of the AMWU were amended to require, inter alia, elections for certain offices by 24 July 2011 (rule 53.24A). Elections are required for the those offices specified in the attached document.
4. This information is lodged under subsection 189(1) of the Act.

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS

1. The following offices and / or positions require elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the reasons given in italics. Pursuant to paragraph 138(1)(d) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* ("the Regulations") the electorate for each office / position is given under the title of the office or position.

2. Pursuant to subregulation 138(1) of the Regulations, Fair Work Australia is advised that for all of the listed offices and / or positions in the Rules of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) provide that:
 - (a) the Returning Officer shall determine the dates for the opening and closing of the nominations (provided that the elections are to be conducted and declared by 24 July 2011).

 - (b) The roll of voters is to be closed on the day that is 7 days before opening date of the nomination period.

 - (c) A collegiate electoral system is to be used in the conduct of the elections.
