

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS

- 1. The following offices and / or positions require elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the reasons given in italics, for the filling of recently vacated positions and/or positions that were not filled at the previous election. Pursuant to paragraph 138(1)(d) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* (the Regulations) the electorate for each office / position is given under the title of the office or position.
 - 2. Pursuant to subregulation 138(1) of the Regulations, Fair Work Australia is advised that for the following offices and / or positions, the Rules of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) provide that:
 - (a) For listed positions elected pursuant to Rule 53 Part C and Rule 53 Part F of the AMWU's Rules, the returning officer is to determine the opening and closing dates for nominations; for other listed positions, nominations shall open no earlier than 7 days and no later than 30 days after the close of the roll of voters;
 - (b) The roll of voters shall close at the nearest practicable end of a quarter following the notification of the election being provided to the Returning Officer by the Industrial Registrar;
 - (c) A direct voting system is to be used in the conduct of the elections.
