I, Paul Bastian, of 133 Parramatta Road, Granville, New South Wales, union official, state as follows:

1. I am the National Secretary of the “Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union” known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers’ Union (AMWU), an organisation of employees registered under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (“the Act”).
2. I am authorised to lodge the information prescribed by regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*.
3. Elections are required for the offices in the Printing Division specified in the attached. These are in addition to the positions notified in the prescribed information filed by the AMWU on 7 August 2013.
4. The offices listed in the attached Prescribed Information are generally conducted in the first half of the year every two years. Rule 53.12 of the Union’s Rules requires that elections for these positions be conducted “every two years”. This is unlike all other direct elections of offices in the Union which are now synchronised to be conducted every four years.

5. Due to an administrative oversight, the attached prescribed information was not lodged when it ordinarily would have, in the first half of the year. The Union has taken steps to ensure such administrative oversight would not occur in the future.
6. To the extent that it may be required, the Union would seek that you allow a later day for the lodgement of the prescribed information under subsection 189(2) of the Act.
7. This information is lodged under subsection 189(1) of the Act.


SUPPORTING STATEMENT

1. I am the National Secretary of the “Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union” known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers’ Union (AMWU), an organisation of employees registered under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (“the Act”).
2. I am authorised to lodge the information prescribed by regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*.
3. Elections are required for the offices in the Printing Division specified in the attached.
4. The offices listed in the attached Prescribed Information are generally conducted in the first half of the year every two years. Rule 53.12 of the Union’s Rules requires that elections for these positions be conducted “every two years”. This is unlike all other direct elections of offices in the Union, excluding the Retired Members Division, which have recently been synchronised to be conducted every four years.

5. Due to an administrative oversight, the attached prescribed information was not lodged when it ordinarily would have, in the first half of the year. The Union has taken steps to ensure such administrative oversight would not occur in the future.
6. To the extent that it may be required, the Union would seek that you allow a later day for the lodgement of the prescribed information under subsection 189(2) of the Act.
