PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS

- The following offices and / or positions require elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the reasons given in italics. Pursuant to paragraph 138(1)(d) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 (the Regulations) the electorate for each office / position is given under the title of the office or position.
 - 2. Pursuant to subregulation 138(1) of the Regulations, Fair Work Australia is advised that for all of the above offices and / or positions in the Rules of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) provide that:
