PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS

- The following offices and / or positions require elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the reasons given in italics. Pursuant to paragraph 138(1)(d) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 ("the Regulations") the electorate for each office / position is given under the title of the office or position.
 - Pursuant to subregulation 138(1) of the Regulations, Fair Work Australia is advised that for the attached office, the Rules of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) ("the Rules") provide that:
 - (a) the Returning Officer shall, no later than 26 weeks before the date of the expiration in term of the office determine the opening and closing dates for lodging nominations, where the closing date is no less than 8 weeks before the opening date of a relevant ballot;
 - (b) the roll of voters shall close 7 days before the opening date of the ballot;
 - (c) a direct voting system is to be used in the conduct of the election.
