#### Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Commission a declaration of results for the election [E2015/191]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 154D(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe.

Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
  - the name of the office vacated;
  - the date of the change of office holder; and
  - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
  - the name of the office now held;
  - the date of the change of office holder;
  - the name of the person now holding the office;
  - the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
  - the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. I have attached a template notification of changes which may assist you. If any change does not apply until a specific date, you don't need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

## SUPPORTING STATEMENT

- I, Paul Bastian, of 133 Parramatta Road, Granville, in the State of New South Wales, union official, state as follows:
- 1. I am the National Secretary of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU), an organisation of employees registered under the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act).
- 2. I am authorised to lodge the information prescribed by regulation 138 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009.
- 3. Elections are required for the offices specified in the attached document.
- 4. There are a number of additional offices in the Union for which no member nominated in the previous ballot where the relevant operational area has advised that these positions are unlikely to attract further nominations should they be put to ballot again. The National Council meeting in June 2015 considered proposals for these offices to be suspended pending review of the structure of the relevant bodies upon which they sit. This resolution, as attached, applied to various offices on the Printing Division Regional Council in Queensland, the Food and Confectionary Regional Council and the Printing Division Regional Council in Western Australia and the Printing Division Regional Council in Tasmania.

#### PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS

- The following offices and / or positions require elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the reasons given in italics. Pursuant to paragraph 138(1)(d) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 ("the Regulations") the electorate for each office / position is given under the title of the office or position.
  - 2. Pursuant to subregulation 138(1) of the Regulations, Fair Work Australia is advised that for all of the listed offices and / or positions in the Rules of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) provide that:
    - (a) Nominations for all offices shall open on the twenty eighth day of the first month of the Quarter which immediately precedes the Quarter in which the term of office of the offices for election expires, and shall close at 12 noon on the twenty-first day after nominations have opened.
    - (b) The roll of voters is to be closed no earlier than 30 days and no later than 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open. Wherever the last day of a Quarter falls within this period, the roll of voters is to be closed on that day. Otherwise the roll of voters is to be closed 7 days prior to the date for the opening of nominations
    - (c) A direct voting system is to be used in the conduct of the elections.
