

    - (a) The Returning Officer shall, no later than 26 weeks before the date of the expiration in term of office determine the opening and closing dates for lodging nominations, where the closing date is no less than 8 weeks before the opening date of the relevant ballot;
    - (b) The roll of voters shall close 7 days before the opening date of the nomination period;
    - (c) A direct voting system is to be used in the conduct of the elections.

## Courtesy Letter - Election for offices [E2016/233]

The rules of the "Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) indicate that an election for offices within the organisation is due to commence shortly.

- National Divisional President (Printing Division)
- Printing Division and Region Offices

It appears that nominations for the election for the above-named offices open in January next year.

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of your obligation to lodge information about the election (known as the 'prescribed information') pursuant to sub-sections 189(1) and (2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the 'Act') within the month. Prescribed information must be lodged with the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) two months before nominations open for the election.

If you have a different interpretation for the commencement of the election or the offices due for election under your rules, please let the Commission know, otherwise, the prescribed information should contain details of the election as required by regulation 138(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* (the 'Regulations'), and any subsequent collegiate elections, if that is relevant. A sample of the prescribed information can be found on our website at https://www.fwc.gov.au/registered-organisations/fact-sheets-templates-webinars.

The prescribed information should be emailed to <a href="mailto:orgs@fwc.gov.au">orgs@fwc.gov.au</a>. If your organisation believes that it will be unable to comply with the prescribed day as set out in the Regulations, it will need to apply to the General Manager within the month for a later date. Such request will need to set out in detail the reason why your organisation is unable to comply with the requirement. While the General Manager will consider such an application, there is no assurance that consent to a later day will be allowed.

It should be noted Section 189(2) is a civil penalty provision. Failure for an organisation to comply may result in legal proceedings being issued with the possibility of a pecuniary penalty being imposed upon an officer and/or the organisation.

The Commission intends to continue to provide reminders that an election is due as a courtesy. However failure to receive a reminder from the Commission cannot be relied on as a reason for late, incorrect or non-lodgment of prescribed information. The obligation to lodge prescribed information consistent with the Act and the rules of the organisation rests with the organisation.
