Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Fair Work Commission a copy of the declarations of a result for the election E2016/245. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 154D(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe and that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission of any changes to the records for the holders of office in the organisation. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the organisation must notify the Commission of these changes. The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. If there have been no changes, a notification is not required.

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS

1. The following offices and / or positions require elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the reasons given in italics. Pursuant to paragraph 138(1)(d) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* (“the Regulations”), the electorate for each office / position is given under the title of the office or position. These positions were filled at the various State Elections conducted in April/May 2016 and we have since received resignations.

2. Pursuant to sub-regulation 138(1) of the Regulations, Fair Work Australia is advised that for all of the listed offices in the Rules of the “Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union” known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers’ Union (AMWU) provide that:
 - (a) Insofar as the vacancy relates to the Manufacturing Membership consistent with Rule 4 – Part B, subrule 14, the Returning Officer shall conduct a postal election in accordance with the provisions of sub-rule 15.

 - (b) Insofar as the vacancy relates to the Food and Confectionery Division, consistent with Rule 53 – Part G, subrule 31 (relating to the Food & Confectionery Division), the Returning Officer shall conduct an election by and from the delegates to that State Conference.

3. Pursuant to sub-regulation 138(1)(g) of the Regulations, the Rules provide that a collegiate electoral system is to be used in the conduct of the elections.
