Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested offices for NSW Vehicle and Food & Confectionery Divisions; Vic Printing Division; Qld Vehicle Division; SA Vehicle, Food & Confectionery and Printing Divisions; and WA Printing Division [E2017/76]. 

[2] The above-named offices include both (a) offices whose current term will expire on 30 June 2017 and for which new terms will commence on 1 July 2017 and (b) casual vacancies that originally arose following resignations at various times in late 2015 and during 2016. In the case of the former, comprising the offices for the Printing Division in South Australia and Western Australia, the offices were not filled in the previous scheduled election E2016/233 due to no nominations having been received. In the case of the latter, comprising all the other offices listed, the offices were not filled in the previous casual vacancy election E2016/211 due likewise to no nominations having been received.²

[3] In both cases this election will represent a further attempt to fill the respective offices, following insufficient nominations having been received at a relevant previous election.
