WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT
SECTION 271A

My name is Charles Voss. I am currently a practising architect and a member and the branch treasurer of the Association of Consulting Architects, Tasmania Branch. I am acting on behalf of the Branch in this matter at the request of the Branch Committee of Management.

In consideration of the Act, on behalf of the Branch, I again wish to apply for a Certificate to exempt the Branch from the requirements of the Act relating to financial matters occurring in the year ending 30 June 2005.

In support of the application.

1. The Branch is the state representation of the national body Association of Consulting Architects Australia.
2. The Branch consists of 10 members only for the financial year, 2004/2005.
3. Membership fees as the only source of income consists of a National and a Chapter component.
4. The branch has an account with the Commonwealth Bank – Account N° 06 7000 00258986. Financial transactions are primarily undertaken as collection of membership fees. Most of these membership fees consist of a national component that is forwarded to the national body on receipt of their tax invoice for the same.
5. For the year ending 30 June 2004, the branch applied for and was granted exemption from the requirements relating to the formal financial reporting under the Act. The branch finds its self in similar circumstances again this financial year ending June 2005 in that the amounts of funds available to pay for compliance auditing fees is of such magnitude that our branch component of membership fees would need to increase significantly.

This step is seen as impractical considering the numbers of members and potential for increased membership in the State.

The alternative is to close the branch for financial reasons resulting in no local representation of the national body for members or to become affiliated with another State Chapter.

6. The Committee of Management consists of financial members elected by the Branch in accordance with the rules of the organisation. The Committee meets regularly and regulates the affairs of the Branch in a thorough and consistent manner. Minutes of each meeting are kept as records and are available on request.
7. For your information we enclose copies of the 2004/2005 documentation that has been forwarded to members by the Secretary, ACA Tasmania prior to the annual general meeting.
8. The annual general meeting was held on 14th December 2005. Notice of this meeting had been forwarded to all members.

Please advise if further information is required to enable you to make a decision.

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


