Hi Sonia,

One further issue in relation to the election for 2 nominees of Governing Bodies of Primary Schools. Would you be able to have the same amended prescribed information, as lodged below, signed by an elected office holder. This is because regulation 138(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisatians) Regulations 2009* requires prescribed information for elections to be signed by an officer.

Thank you for the correspondence lodged below.
