As outlined in Federal Rule 16.1.1, there shall be one position on the National Assembly which shall be filled by women members of the Association and a further two positions filled by members as defined in Rule 3.2. (i.e. Professional Scientists)

Any National Assembly member may only occupy one National Assembly position and where an eligible member nominates for more than one National Assembly position as provided in these Rules, the position to which that member shall be elected shall be in the order or priority of a position for members eligible under Rule 3.2, a Division defined under Rule 6.2, a Branch defined under Rule 6.1 and then a position for a women member of the Association.

Nominations for the positions on the National Assembly are to be called for after the seventeenth day of September and before the first day of October 2001, and are to be returned to the Returning Officer by the fifteenth day of October 2001, and shall meet the requirements as specified in Branch Rule 14 of the Association's Constitution and Rules.

Should a ballot be required for the positions on the National Assembly, ballot papers, together with information as provided for under the Branch Rule 14.1.3 of the Association's Constitution and Rules, should be sent to each financial member in the electorate for which a ballot is required no later than the fifteenth day of November next ensuing. Ballot papers are then to be returned to the address specified by the Returning Officer so as to ensure to be received no later than the twenty-ninth day of November next ensuing.

The voting system which is to be used for National Assembly elections is the direct voting system.

National Board of Management

The following National Board of Management positions exist as outlined in Federal Rule 18 of the Association's Constitution and Rules:

National President
National Senior Vice-President
National Vice President (3 positions)
National Secretary
National Treasurer

In the case where at least one woman member nominates for a position on the Board, and no woman is elected to the Board, the woman candidate with the highest number of votes shall fill an additional position of Vice President on the Board (see Federal Rule 18.3.1).

The electorate for the positions on the National Board consists of members of the National Assembly holding office in accordance with the Constitution and Rules of the Association for the ensuing year (see Federal Rule 18.3)

Nominations for the National Board positions are to be called for before the thirtieth day of November from members of the National Assembly holding office for the ensuing year, and are to be returned to the address specified by the Returning Officer no later than the fifteenth day of January, and shall meet the requirements as specified in Federal Rule 18 of the Association's Constitution and Rules. Members of the National Assembly may nominate for more than one position (but can only be elected to one position). The order of filling such positions shall be National President, National Senior Vice President, National Secretary, National Treasurer, National Vice President.

Should a ballot be required for the positions on the National Board, ballot papers, together with information as provided for under Federal Rule 18.4, are to be sent to each member of the National Assembly by the thirty-first day of January next ensuing. Ballot papers should be returned to the Returning Officer not later than the fourteenth day of February next ensuing.
