



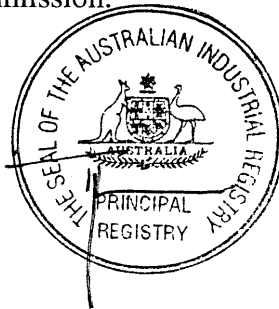

The Association has received the report of the Returning Officer in relation to the above elections following the close of nominations on 15 October 2001. The Returning Officer's report indicates that there are a number of positions which remain unfilled as a result of insufficient nominations being received for those positions.

As these positions involve a period of office in excess of 2 years (Federal Rule 26.4), under the provisions of the Industrial Relations Act and the Association Rules, the election to fill these positions is required to be undertaken by the Australian Electoral Commission. The positions on the Association's National Assembly which have not been filled due to insufficient nominations being received are as follows:

- ✓ • Tasmanian Branch – 1 position
- ✓ • ABC Senior Executives Division – 1 positions
- ✓ • Telstra and Australia Post Senior Managers Division – 2 positions

The electorates in relation to these officers are as follows:

- Tasmanian Branch – all financial members of the Association resident in Tasmania
 - ABC Senior Executives Division – all financial members of the Association who are members of the Division
 - Telstra and Australian Post Senior Manager Division – all financial members of the Association who are members of the Division.
- ✓ In accordance with Federal Rule 26, the vacancy is to be filled within 2 months of its occurrence.
- ✓ The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is a direct voting system.

It would be appreciated if you could arrange for the Australian Electoral Commission to conduct the elections to fill these positions.
